

BASIC TIPS:

- Research the company you're interviewing with to learn about its history, culture, leadership team, products, and any relevant news and events so you can formulate informed questions for your interview.
- In your interview, ask questions about company culture and "fit," expectations of new hires, and how you'll be evaluated once on the job in addition to other questions.
- Ask questions that let your interviewer know you're up to date and well versed on the organization and its happenings which can set you apart from the other job candidates.
- Prepare a list of questions before your interview and take it with you so you can reference it if needed. It's acceptable to refer to your notes, so you don't forget the questions you want to ask.

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
