

Quick Tips: Perils of Social Media

BASIC TIPS:

- A survey by CareerBuilder says 70% of employers use social media to research job candidates; 57% of those employers says they've found content online that caused them *not* to hire a candidate.
- Remember, whatever you post on social media lives forever. Be cautious about what you post especially if it pertains to your employer.
- When you prepare for a job interview, employers suggest keeping this information private, advising not to post about it on social media.
- Keep in mind whether it's personal or work related, what you post online can
 potentially impact your career. A good rule of thumb: if you wouldn't want
 your mom or grandmother to see what you've posted, don't post it on social
 media.
- Be sure your social media is representative of who you are as a person since you are projecting your brand to the world.
